INTRODUCTION

This report addresses the delegations from Council to Town Planning Officers.

ANALYSIS

At its 12 May 2009 Ordinary Meeting, the Council made a number of delegations to Council staff, following a review as required by the Local Government Act 1989.

The delegations to Town Planning staff require an adjustment in relation to the criteria for permit applications being referred to Council, as follows:

Applications for planning permits in the following categories are to be referred to Council for decision:

- (i) projects in excess of \$1,500,000 and major development proposals;*
- (ii) any other application where it is considered to be warranted by the relevant delegated officer or a Councillor.*

No other changes are considered to be required.
