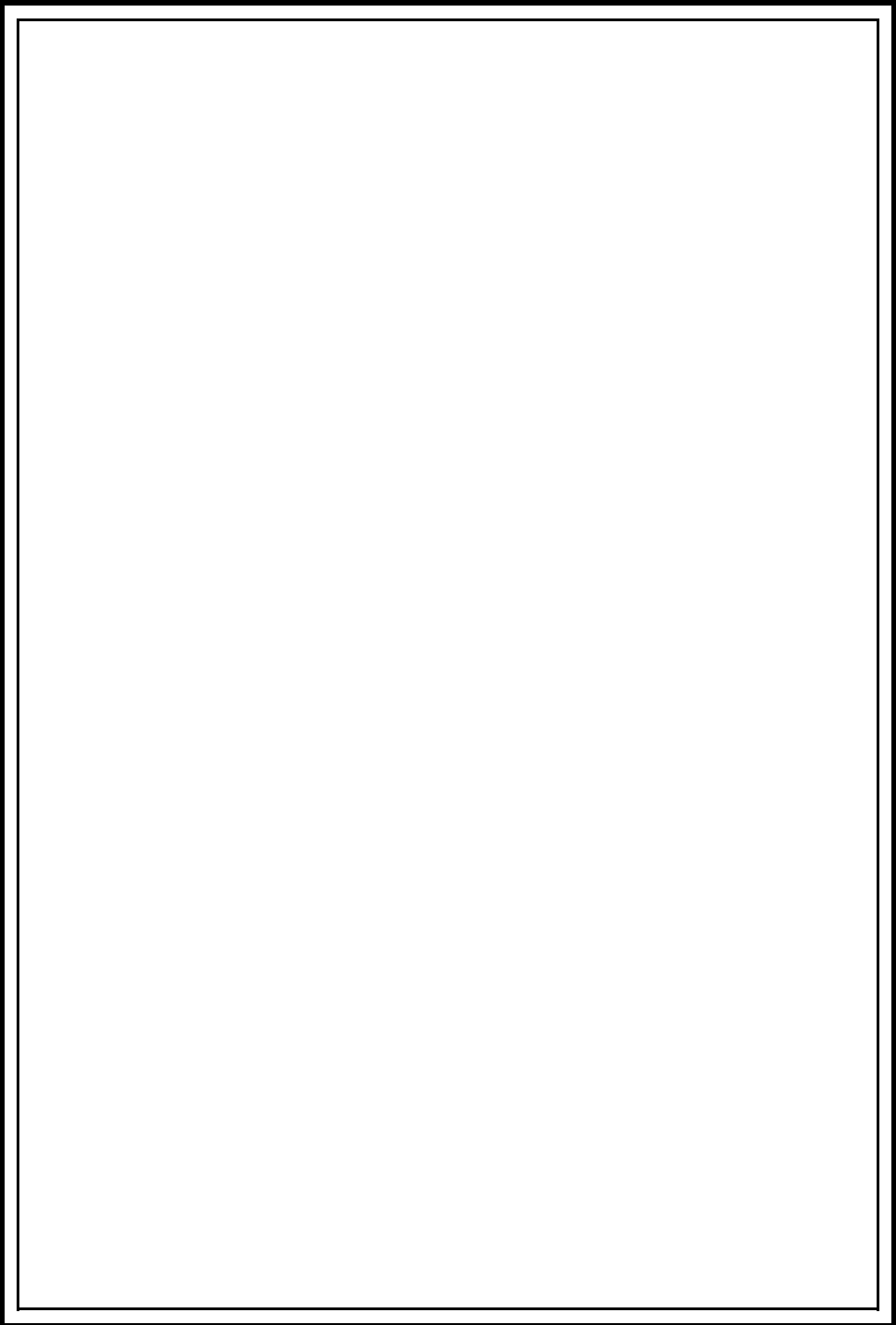

PRESCHOOL

Preschool or kindergarten is for 3 and 4 year old children.

Preschools in the City of Monash offer sessional programs.

The session times outlined in this guide may change from year to year based on a preschool's number of enrolments and parents' needs. Session times listed in this booklet are for 2009.

Operating costs for four year old preschool sessions are partially subsidised by the State Government and the remainder is covered by parents' fees. The fees are set by the Committee of Management and are based on the hours of attendance and the number of children attending the service. Three year old preschool sessions are not funded by the State Government and the preschools depend entirely on fees to operate them. Contact the preschools for more information about fees.

The Committee of Management is made up of parents and other volunteers and is responsible for managing the preschool.

PRESCHOOL

Learning through Play

Preschool is a place where an educational program will allow children to:

- ❖ Choose a variety of open ended experiences.
- ❖ Use safe and challenging equipment and resources.
- ❖ Participate in individual learning experiences planned by a highly qualified, university trained teacher who is supported by a caring assistant.
- ❖ Receive support and encouragement from staff members.

Your child will learn:

- ❖ Social skills – respect for others, co-operation, sharing, taking turns;
- ❖ Language skills – express ideas clearly, talk with and listen to others;
- ❖ Physical skills – co-ordination, balance, fine and gross motor skills;
- ❖ Confidence – being part of a group, self esteem, resilience;
- ❖ Self - help skills – looking after possessions, independence;
- ❖ Cognitive skills – problem solving, introduction to literacy and numeracy.

These skills are learnt through active play.
Preschool programs are rich in child-centred,
directed and open-ended opportunities for autonomous and
active learning.

Three and Four Year Old Preschool Central Registration through the City of Monash

The Central Enrolment Register is supported by the City of Monash and the Monash Preschool Association to assist preschools with the administration of enrolments.

Victorian State Government Policy states that a child is entitled to funding for **ONE** year of a 4 year old preschool experience ONLY. When applying for preschool, parents need to carefully consider the age of their child and whether he/she will be ready for the demands of preschool. Your local preschool teacher is available to discuss these matters.

It is recommended that parents enrol their child as soon as possible after turning 18 months. Children must turn either three or four years old on or before 30 April the year they attend preschool. Children who turn three years old between 1 February and the 30 April cannot start preschool until after their third birthday.

Council requires that preschools operating from Council buildings allocate the majority of places to residents of Monash.

In receiving each application form, the Central Enrolment Register can give no guarantee that a place will be available in the preschool nominated or in any preschool within the municipality.

Availability of places in individual preschools is determined by the number of sessions and places offered each year as decided by the preschools. The initial series of offers will generally be made by the preschools in third term.

Wayburne Preschool offers programs which are progressive and flexible, and are planned to cater for the individual needs of your child. Four year old preschoolers are taught literacy skills and numeracy skills in a fun way.

Wayburne operates a privately funded 3 year old group consisting of 22 children, and two government subsidised 4 year old groups consisting of 23 children, with a maximum of 28 on 'extended hours' days.

Children enrolling for the 3 year old group must have turned three on or before 1 February in the year they attend. Children enrolling for the 4 year old group must turn four on or before the 30 April in the year they attend, and are accepted in accordance with Monash Council's Central Registration list. Preference is given to children who attended 3 year old kinder; siblings of previous attendees (within last three year period); residents of Monash Council area; applicant has applied to attend the 4 year old program.

It is recommended that parents visit their preferred preschools to obtain information such as **session times** and **fees**, before nominating their preferred preschools on the application form. Please be aware that some preschools have additional enrolment criteria that may influence your child's enrolment.

If your child does not obtain a place at your preferred preschool, Council's Preschool Officer will be able to assist with other options.

Should a parent wish to vary any of the information on the original application, i.e. preschool preferences, year of attendance, change of address, etc. an "Alteration of Preschool Enrolment Application" form must be sent to the City of Monash. These forms are available from Council offices, Council website and Preschools.

Preschool applications must be received by **30 June** prior to the year of attending to be considered in the initial allocations. Applications received after that date will be regarded as late applications and will be considered after all applications received before **30 June** are dealt with.

If a parent requests a change of preference before **30 June** prior to the year their child is registered to attend, the **ORIGINAL** Date Received will remain the same. A change of preference received after the **30 June** will attract **the new date**. If a parent requests a change of preference without a change of address, a further fee is payable.

Should forms be received prior to your child being 18 months of age or without payment, they will be returned to you to be resubmitted and will attract the later date of registration.

PROCEDURE FOR ALLOCATION OF PLACES

The first round of offers are mailed out by Preschools in July and subsequent offers will be made until preschools are full. Should your child not have access to a place in the preschool of your first preference, Council's Preschool Support Officer will assist in finding a place for your child in your additional preference or other alternatives. Please note your child's name is only on the list of your first preference preschool, in order of Date Received.

Children with Additional Needs

A parent who considers that their child has additional needs at the time of application for enrolment must apply for recognition of this status through the preschool to allow an application for further funding to be sought should it be needed. Supportive documentation from other agencies will be needed in the further application.

"Learning through play" at the preschool is set to get even better as we offer parents the chance to tailor their child's preschool experience with programs specifically designed to meet developmental needs during their formative years.

Our 3 year old group has been revamped to meet the needs of our younger learners. Children who turn 3 between 1 January and 30 April are eligible to enrol.

The new Deferred 4 year old group (D4) is for children who are 3 by 1 January in the year they are eligible to attend 3 year old sessions, or preferably turning 4 between 1 January and 30 June in the year they are eligible to attend 3 or 4 year old sessions.

A rotational model was introduced to the 4 year old group due to increased enrolments. Our preschool gives preference to those who attended the 3 year old program and/or have siblings who attend/ed the preschool.

THE THREE R'S

Before I can learn to *READ* I need to know:

- ❖ What a book is?
- ❖ That it contains words and pictures.
- ❖ That these words are what is read.
- ❖ That a book has a beginning and an end – back and front.
- ❖ I need to learn to love and care for books in order to want to read.
- ❖ I may begin to understand that reading (and writing) is done from left to right, top to bottom and that each printed word represents one spoken word.
- ❖ I may not learn all of these pre-reading skills before I am 5 but I will learn some of them.

BOOKS ARE ENJOYABLE! I can find out and appreciate many things and my language and listening skills grow with lots of stories, poems, singing, puppets, games and music.

Before I can learn to *WRITE* I need to know:

- ❖ What happens when I put pencils or paint to paper.
- ❖ Be able to hold a pencil or brush comfortably.
- ❖ Have time to scribble, draw circles and make shapes before I am able to draw things. This may take me a while.
- ❖ Enjoy drawing and painting in order to learn to write.
- ❖ Learn about letters and words, what they look like, how they are formed and in what order they go in, ie. my name.
- ❖ I need you to support and encourage me even if you can not see what I have created. I am experimenting and learning and not concentrating and what is right or wrong.

BUT MOST IMPORTANTLY – I'll need lots of practice, plenty of paper, paints and pencils.

Before I can learn *MATHEMATICS* I need to know:

- ❖ The names of numbers.
- ❖ Be able to say them in the right order.
- ❖ Match each number with the correct amount of things.
- ❖ Know the names of shapes and colours and to be able to match them.
- ❖ Put things that are alike into sets/groups.
- ❖ Learn that things can be put into order (smallest to biggest).
- ❖ Learn about size and weight.
- ❖ Learn about space (in, on, behind, through).

It is important to remember that I learn pre maths in all areas of the kinder.

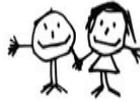

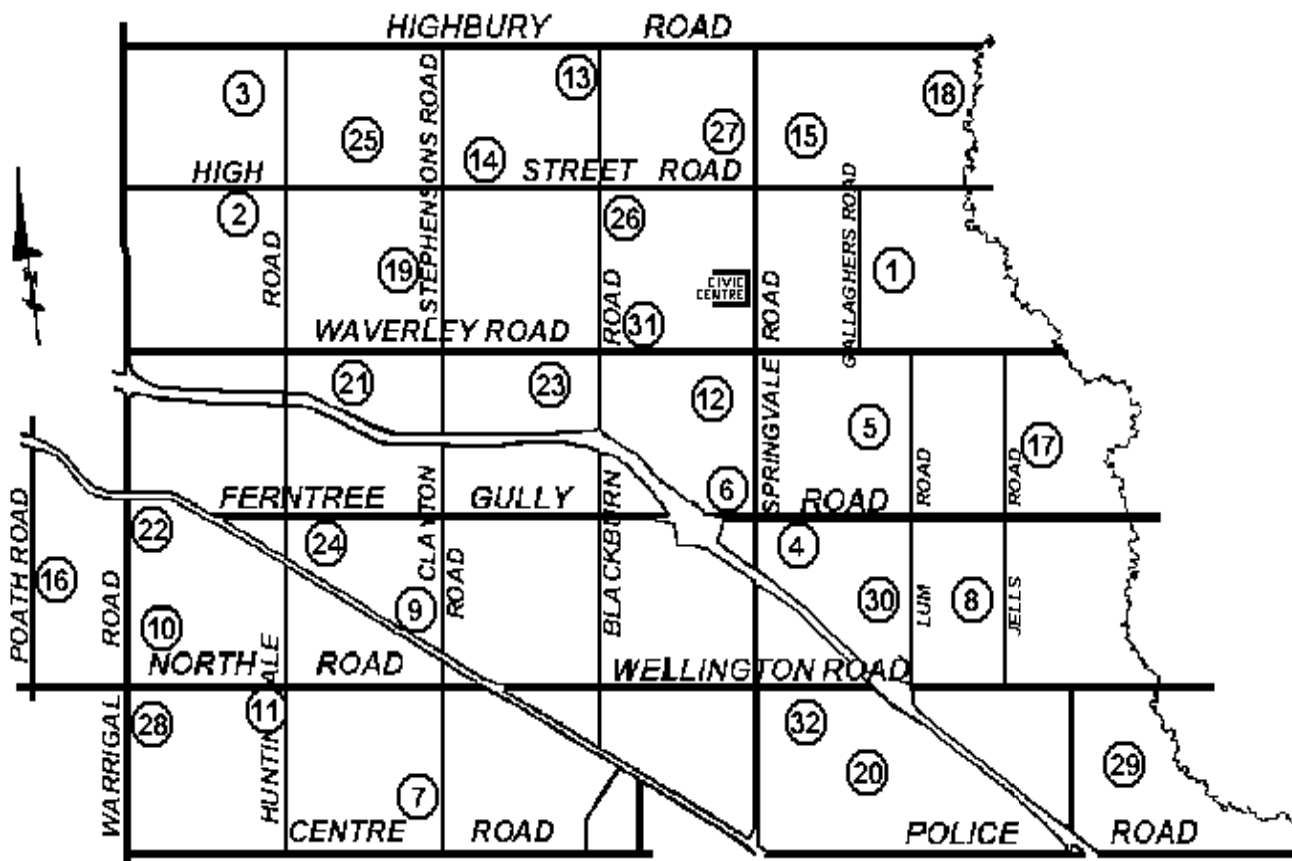
