Murrumbeena to Malvern Flood Mitigation Project

Dandenong Road closed to through traffic

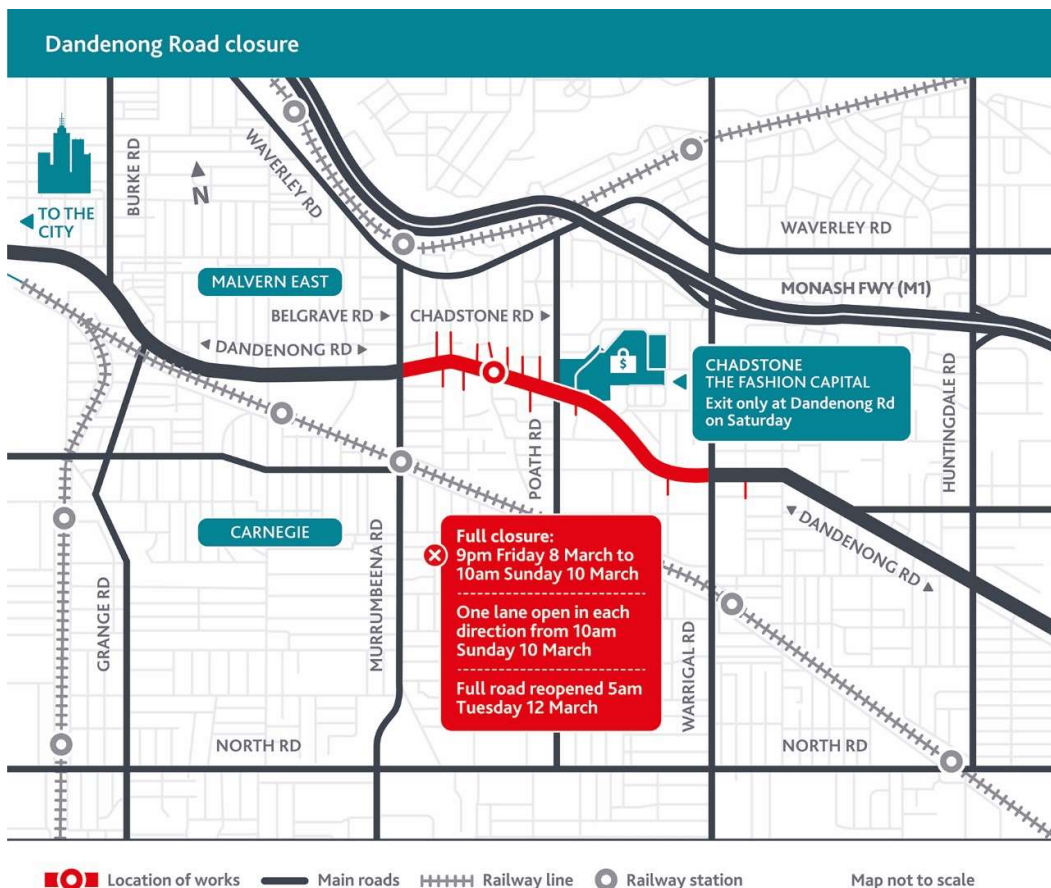
Full closure from 9pm Friday 8 March until 10am Sunday 10 March between Belgrave/Murrumbeena Road and Warrigal Road.

From 10am on Sunday 10 March one lane in each direction will be reopened.

At 5am Tuesday 12 March all lanes will be reopened to traffic.

As a result of this closure there will be a significant increase in traffic delays. It is recommended that drivers avoid the area, plan ahead to consider alternative routes and allow extra time.

We will be working 24/7 to install a new stormwater drain across Dandenong Road and to complete the works as quickly as possible. Additional noise, lights and truck movements will be experienced in the area.



Bus services maintained however some bus stops will be closed

Bus stops between Belgrave/Murrumbeena Road and Chadstone/Poath Road will be closed over the long weekend. Bus stops between Chadstone/Poath Road and Warrigal Road will remain open.

Bus routes 623, 624, 626, 822, 900 and 969 will remain in service and will stop at bus stops on either side of the work zone. Contact PTV on 1800 800 007 or via their website at www.ptv.vic.gov.au for more information.

Access to Chadstone Shopping Centre and local businesses

Recommended access to Chadstone Shopping Centre during the works is via Warrigal Road and Chadstone Road. Surrounding businesses will remain open during the road closure. Please seek assistance from traffic controllers to help you access local businesses.

Living locally during works

During the Labour Day long weekend, the closure of Dandenong Road will impact residents in different ways depending on where you live and where you are going. We encourage you to allow extra time and plan your journey accordingly. While normal resident access routes may be closed, alternatives will be made available.

Side streets in the affected area will be open to local traffic only to ensure passing drivers do not use the side streets as 'rat runs.' Further information specifically related to access to your street will be provided by a bulletin letterbox drop.

Emergency services access will be maintained at all times.
