Buildings and Recreation Infrastructure

- 01 New or expanded clubroom for the Waverly City Archers (200m²)
- 02 Potential future indoor archery and fencing centre (600m²)

Landscape and Amenity

- 03 Potential picnic locations including shelters
- 04 Potential children's exploration/activity zone
- 05 Potential terraced spectator viewing area and access to sportsfield. Shade structure over
- 06 Potential ephemeral wetland walk including boardwalk viewing platform/rest area.
- 07 Potential new location of cricket practice nets and soccer goal storage in summer
- 08 Opportunities for infill planting to increase amenity
- ELP Existing flood lights
- ELP(R) Existing flood light to to be relocated and upgraded to training standard (minimum 50 lux)
- FL Install new flood light to training standard (minimum 50 lux)

Movement Network

Roads:

- 09 Potential re-alignment of existing roadway/car park to accommodate additional spaces (up to 18 new)
- 10 Potential additional parking for Archery Club
- 11 Form parallel parking to Southern edge of the reserve access road and install bollards along the northern edge
- 12 Potential location for splitter island to separate traffic around corner

Pedestrian and Cyclists:

- 13 Potential minor entry points to reserve
- 14 New path provides alternative access to pavilion areas
- 15 Potential raised crossing to slow traffic
- 16 Potential realignment of circuit path required around new building and car park
- 17 Potential stair access with bike ramps to sides
- 18 Potential stair access from realigned Melbourne Water embankment to sports fields
- 19 New DDA compliant access path to archery range

Melbourne Water and Drainage Works

- Extent of embankment rectification works (+300mm increase to existing finished surface level)
- 20 Existing drainage infrastructure to be updated
- 21 Replace swale with underground drainage to increase sports playing area
- Existing trees to be removed as part of Melbourne Water works
- Extent of land subject to inundation

Sport and Archery Arrangement

- 22 Relocation of archery range 10m to the East and removal of existing mound to make room for additional archery targets (16-17)
- 23 Install demarcation low fence for archery range
- 24 Minor realignment of the three soccer fields (3 x 100m x 68m soccer pitches with 3m run off to all edges)
- 25 Relocate concrete centre wicket to achieve 2 x 60m radius cricket ovals.
